

2011 CoARC Distinguished RRT Credentialing Success Award

In selecting programs for this recognition, the CoARC Board used objective criteria based on key accreditation metrics documented in the 2011 Annual Report of Current Status (RCS). These programs were required to: (1) have three or more years of outcomes data; (2) hold accreditation without a progress report; (3) document RRT credentialing success of 90% or above, and (4) meet or exceed established CoARC thresholds for CRT credentialing success, attrition and positive (job) placement. Thirty-two (32) out of approximately 440 programs in the country met these criteria (see next page for a list of recipients). The CoARC extends its sincere congratulations to these programs, their faculty, students, and graduates for meeting these rigorous criteria. The following recipients received the 2011 CoARC Distinguished RRT Credentialing Success Award certificate during a CoARC reception preceding the 2012 AARC Summer Forum.
