Augusta University, invites applications for a 12-month faculty position in the Bachelors of Science Respiratory Therapy Program housed in the Department of Undergraduate Health Professions, College of Allied Health Sciences. The primary duties and responsibilities of this position include the development and delivery of lectures and laboratory courses, teaching in the classroom, online, laboratory and clinical rotations. The candidate should expect to teach 24 credit hours or the equivalent during the year. Additional responsibilities include service and assisting with recruitment activities, admissions and advisement processes for the program; assisting the Program Director with program-related assessment and administrative tasks, and providing service (public, professional and institutional) and research/scholarly activity in accordance with effort allocation. Candidates will find an academic environment that encourages research activities such as professional presentations and publication of peer reviewed articles. This is a 12-month appointment. Rank and salary will be commensurate with education and experience.
