- COVID Policy Update- At its July 2022 Board meeting, the CoARC will be discussing the prospect of ending its flexible policy approach that has been in place during the pandemic. While the CoARC's [December 2021 COVID Policy](#) will remain in effect through August 31, 2022, programs that permanently plan to retain any curricular changes during this flexibility period will be required to submit the appropriate section(s) of the [substantive change application](#) to CoARC as soon as possible.
- The [ARCF awards and grants](#) deadline is June 1, 2022.
- The office will be closed on Monday, May 30th, in observance of Memorial Day and Monday, July 4th, in observance of Independence Day.
