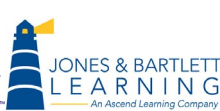

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HOW TO HOST

If you're able to meet the minimum requirements:

- 1. Contact**
our office: email info@ketteringseminars.com
- 2. Coordinate**
with our Executive Director to schedule the dates. Schedule early to confirm your preferred dates.
- 3. Confirm**
by submitting the required deposits (\$85 each) at least 75 days prior to the seminar.

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- Provide a classroom at no charge, with a minimum seating capacity of 40.
- Find 12 or more participants who will commit to participating in the seminar.
- Submit an \$85 deposit from each participant at least 75 days in advance.

Requirements for hosting a 2-Day NPS®, PFT®, CCT®, AE-C®, ACCS® or Sleep Tech Seminar:

- Provide a classroom at no charge, with a minimum seating capacity of 35.
- Find 15 or more participants who will commit to participating in the seminar.
- Submit an \$85 deposit from each participant at least 75 days in advance.
